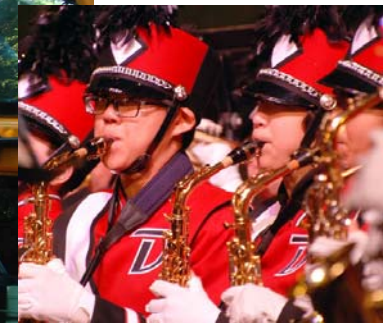

Review of DRAFT Options

New options F and G have been drafted based on committee feedback from Meeting #3

Things to remember about DRAFT options:

- Nothing is written in stone
- Existing DRAFT Options are subject to change
- New options can be created
- Meetings #4 and #5: Committee begins to rule out options they feel do not meet the objectives and criteria
- Focus is still to deliberate and select options to share at the Public Information Session, not to select the recommended plan
