

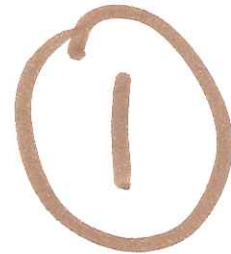
Victory Villa ES Boundary Study Committee – Meeting 7 Voting Results

Thursday, April 20, 2017

- Nominations and voting with members of the Victory Villa ES boundary study committee occurred during the meeting.
- Principals contributed to discussion, but did not nominate options or cast voting stickers.
- 3 Options were nominated by committee members:
 - Option B with modification that Planning Block PB86 move to Martin Boulevard ES (B-1)
 - Option D with modification that Planning Block PB86 move to Martin Boulevard ES (D-1)
 - Option E with modification that Planning Block PB38 move to Shady Spring ES (E-1)
- **16 voting committee members were present.**
- 1st round of voting:
 - Voting members signed for 2 blue stickers (16 votes x 2 stickers = 32 votes issued).
 - Voting members were instructed to cast 1 or 2 votes, with no more than 1 vote per option.
 - Some committee members chose to cast only 1 vote.
 - Results (blue stickers):
 - B-1 1 vote
 - D-1 12 votes
 - E-1 9 votes
 - Option B-1 was removed from consideration.
- 2nd round of voting:
 - Voting members signed for 1 red sticker.
 - Voting members were instructed to cast 1 vote.
 - 16 votes were issued. 16 votes were cast. No voting members abstained from voting.
 - Results (red stickers):
 - D-1 10 votes
 - E-1 6 votes
 - **Option D-1 is the option recommended by the committee**

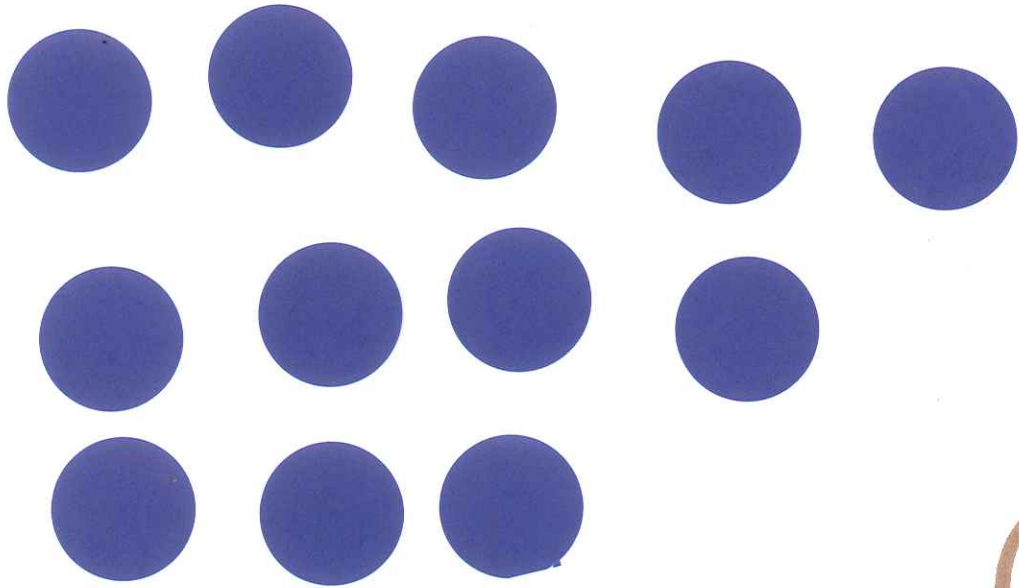

TB 86 to Martin Blvd ES

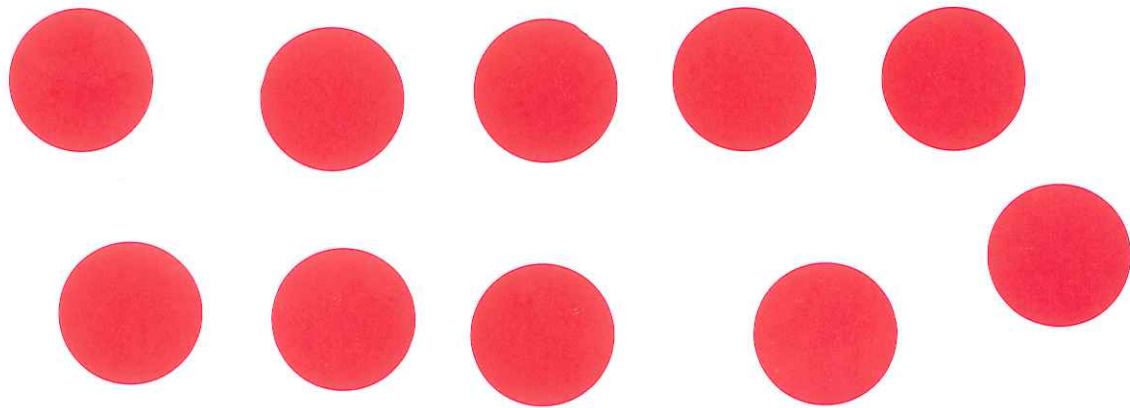


Option D-1

PB 86 to Martin Blvd ES



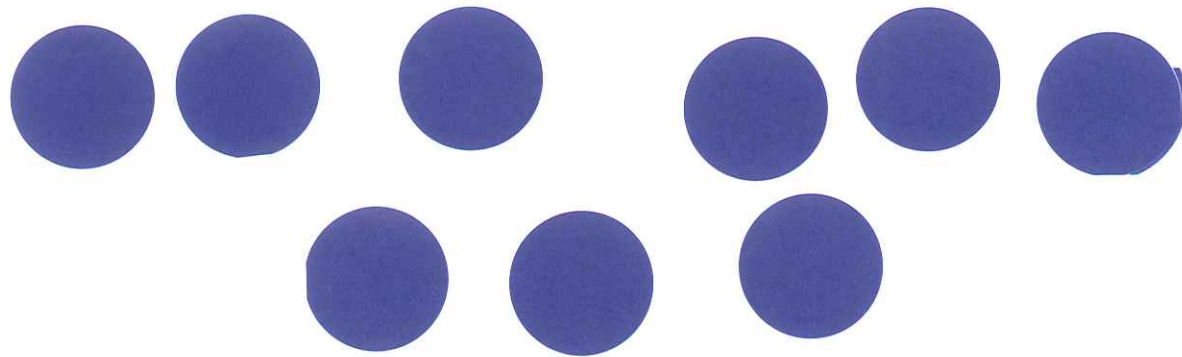
