**Enrollment Procedures**

Families must call the ESOL Intake Center to make an appointment Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. **Please call 410-887-6752.**

- All students not born in the United States who are new to Baltimore County Public Schools, including those who already speak English and have transfer cards from other U.S. schools.
- All students who are citizens of the United States and whose home language is not English.

English Language Learners are assessed at the Office of World Languages at the time of the appointment. This process includes:

- Testing of English proficiency
- Evaluation of foreign transcripts
- Recommendation for grade placement

Students must come to the Office of World Languages with a parent/legal guardian and bring with them the following documents:

- Proof of residency in Baltimore County – rental/lease or property tax bill plus 3 pieces of recent mail with name and address
- Proof of age of student – birth certificate, passport, or an alien registration card
- Proof of education –transcripts or report cards from schools previously attended
- Photo ID of parent or legal guardian

Any documents presented during the interview will be treated confidentially. The information they contain will be used for school purposes only.

**Directions to the ESOL Intake Center at Old Court Middle School**

Take the Beltway (I-695) to exit 20, Reisterstown Road – SOUTH.

Travel 0.7 mile to Old Court Road, turn right onto Old Court Road.

Drive 2 miles to the school on the left, make a left onto Rolling Road.

Park in the back of the building and follow the signs to the ESOL Intake Center.
