- All submissions must be in Times New Roman, 12 pt. font, and double-spaced.
- All works must have a title.
- Each page must be numbered and include the writer's last name. Print clearly!
- Nonfiction entries may be personal essay, memoir, or journalistic in nature.
- Poetry must be no longer than 50 lines.
- Nonfiction and fiction must be no longer than 10 double-spaced pages.

Winners will be notified in early April and invited to attend a special award ceremony hosted by the contest sponsors, the Senior Literary Arts Class of 2017.
