Community Engagement Opportunities

The community engagement process led by Sage Policy Group, the study consultant, includes three components for seeking input from the community: focus groups, public information sessions, and online surveys.

June 2018 – Focus Groups

Community members will discuss and review priorities, options, and strategies for providing enough high school seats for growing enrollment. Feedback will be used to develop a set of options and strategies.

June/July 2018 – Prepare Options and Strategies based on Focus Group Feedback

July 2018 – Public Information Sessions and Online Survey

The purpose of the Public Information Sessions is to gather feedback from all community members on priorities, options and strategies for addressing growing enrollment in high schools. There will be a brief presentation, and the community will be able to review and discuss options and strategies with staff, and complete the online survey.

The dates and locations for the first round of Public Information Sessions is below. The online survey will run from July 9 – 22, 2018, and will be translated into six languages: Arabic, Chinese, French, Russian, Spanish, and Vietnamese.
