Student Accident Insurance Program

I. Policy Statement

- A. The Board of Education of Baltimore County (Board) will make student accident insurance available to the parent or guardian of each student who is enrolled in a Baltimore County Public School (BCPS).
- B. The Board believes that participation in athletic programs is valuable and that all students should have access to accident insurance.

II. Process

- A. A parent/guardian who chooses to purchase student accident insurance shall select the type of coverage and pay the premium directly to the company.
- B. The contract shall be between the parent/guardian and the insurance company. The Board shall assume no role or responsibility with regard to the insurance purchased or settling of any claims arising from the policy.
- C. The Superintendent shall ensure that student accident insurance enrollment materials are made available to all students at the beginning of each school year.

III. Accident Reporting

All accidents, regardless of the type of insurance coverage, must be reported in accordance with Board Policy, Superintendent's Rules, or school system operating procedures.

IV. Implementation

The Board directs the Superintendent to implement this policy.
