



NON-INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES: Food Services

Food Service Finance

I. Policy Statement

- A. The Board of Education of Baltimore County (Board) will provide a systemwide school food service program in compliance with applicable state and federal laws and regulations.
- B. It is the intent of the Board that the school food service program be self-supporting and that revenues received shall be used solely to finance the cost of providing the program's services.

II. Guidelines

- A. The Superintendent shall maintain a financial management system as authorized by federal and state laws and regulations and establish guidelines for determining meal prices and safeguarding the program's assets.
- B. The accounts of the school food service program shall be included in the Board's annual audit.

III. Implementation

The Board directs the Superintendent to implement this policy.
