Psychological Services

I. Policy Statement

- A. The Board of Education of Baltimore County (Board) is committed to ensuring that all students have equitable access to a comprehensive continuum of psychological consultation, assessment, and intervention services as part of the coordinated student services provided in all schools.
- B. The Board believes that a comprehensive continuum of psychological services, provided by highly qualified school psychologists, is essential to addressing the educationally relevant learning, behavioral, and mental health needs of all students, including students with targeted and intensive needs, and supporting high academic achievement and continuous growth in safe and secure teaching and learning environments.

II. Implementation

The Board directs the Superintendent to implement this policy.
