



NON-INSTRUCTIONAL SERVICES: Fees, Gifts and Property Disposition

Nonresident Student Tuition

I. Nonresident Student Tuition

- A. The Department of Fiscal Services will be responsible for:
 - 1. Establishing tuition rates for nonresident students by no later than June 15 of each year for the succeeding fiscal year; and
 - 2. Posting current tuition rates on the school system's Web site.

- B. Tuition Rates
 - 1. Except as provided in subparagraph I(B)(2) below, the tuition rate for students whose parent(s) or guardian(s) are not residents of Baltimore County is calculated on the basis of the proportionate share of county costs of educating a student for the prior fiscal year, adjusted for student-specific program requirements.
 - 2. The tuition rate for the enrollment of a child of an employee who is domiciled outside of Baltimore County will be assessed in accordance with Superintendent's Rule 5150, *Resident and Nonresident Students' Eligibility*.

- C. The Department of Fiscal Services will implement procedures for invoicing and collecting nonresident tuition payments.
