Officers, Duties: <u>President, Vice President</u>

The president, except in cases when [he/she is] unable to attend, shall preside at all meetings [in] OF the Board OF EDUCATION OF BALTIMORE COUNTY (BOARD) and [he/she] shall have a vote on motions placed before the Board for action. THE PRESIDENT [He/she] shall sign such documents on behalf of the Board as may require his/her signature. THE PRESIDENT [He/she] shall represent the Board in deliberations with other b[B]oards, districts, or agencies unless another member of the B[b]oard is so designated.
- II. The vice-president shall perform all duties of the president when [he/she is] acting in that capacity, except as otherwise provided by law.
